Roles and Responsibilities of an Anti-Ragging Monitoring Cell

Anti-Ragging Monitoring Cell has been established in our campus to ensure a **safe, respectful, and inclusive environment** for students, free from any form of ragging. Below are the **key roles and responsibilities** of this cell:

1. Prevention and Awareness

- **Conduct awareness campaigns** (orientation programs, seminars, posters, and circulars) to educate students about the consequences of ragging.
- **Promote a culture of mutual respect** and emphasize the institution's **zero-tolerance policy** toward ragging.
- **Display anti-ragging information** prominently on notice boards, websites, and hostels.

2. Monitoring and Supervision

- **Regularly monitor vulnerable locations** such as hostels, canteens, corridors, and recreation areas.
- **Ensure faculty vigilance** and appoint **anti-ragging squads** or committees for surprise checks.
- Maintain **close coordination with hostel wardens, security staff, and class mentors** to detect early signs of ragging.

3. Complaint Handling

- **Receive and document complaints** (written, oral, or online) related to ragging from students, parents, or staff.
- **Ensure confidentiality** and protection for complainants.
- **Refer serious cases** to the institution's **Anti-Ragging Committee** for investigation and disciplinary action.

4. Investigation and Reporting

- **Assist the Anti-Ragging Committee** in conducting prompt and impartial inquiries into reported incidents.
- **Prepare periodic reports** on ragging incidents, preventive measures, and outcomes for submission to higher authorities or regulatory bodies (like the University Grants Commission (UGC) or AICTE).

5. Coordination with External Bodies

- **Liase with local police, district administration, and the UGC monitoring cell** when required.
- **Ensure compliance** with directives issued by statutory and regulatory bodies regarding anti-ragging policies.

6. Review and Feedback

- **Evaluate the effectiveness** of anti-ragging measures periodically.
- **Recommend improvements** in policies, procedures, or infrastructure to strengthen preventive mechanisms.
- **Encourage student feedback** to identify areas needing more vigilance or awareness.

7. Support and Counselling

- **Provide counselling and support** to victims of ragging.
- **Guide accused students** (if not found guilty) toward behavioural correction and sensitization.
