Who should attend?

1. All Faculty members / PGs desirous of publishing their scientific work.
2. The faculty can co-opt their PG / research partner across depts. or institutions for the workshop.
3. The maximum number of participants is 40 teams – each team comprising of two members.

Workshop Objectives

At the end of the workshop, the Participants shall be able to

1. Describe the publication process.
2. Describe the role of impact factor in scientific publications.
3. Demonstrate an understanding of why manuscriptst get rejected.
4. Analyse Qualitative and Quantitative data
5. Visualize and report data for dissemination of their research fundings.
6. Prepare a manuscript in IMRAD format
7. Demonstrate appropriate and effective use of English language for scientific communications.
8. Discuss the results of their study and their implication.
9. Explain Publication ethics and role of plagiarised content in scientific misconduct.
10. Use appropriate software for referencing and citation management.
11. Demonstrate the ability to choose an appropriate journal to showcase their research work.

- All faculty participants should prepare their manuscript in a systematic manner & send it for publication within one month.
- Get it published in an indexed journal within three months time.
