






Breast Feeding Week Celebration by Department of Paediatrics

Camp and Outreach Activities

Aarupadai Veedu College and Hospital is providing free medical care to the rural and urban population through outreach medical camps and health centres. The main objective is to improve the health of the communities in Puducherry, Villupuram and Cuddalore districts. Over the past 20years AVMCH have conducted more than 700 medical camps in collaboration with local village leaders, Government and NGO's .

We have conducted 24 Multispecialty medical camps were treated 3349 patients at medical camps and 372 patients had been referred for













further treatment at AVMC hospital July-August-September in the area of Puducherry, Villupuram and Cuddalore districts. The preventive, education wellness and health awareness programs were also conducted through these medical camps.

To mention few preventive programs like immunization against various diseases and health education programs on hygiene practices, suicide prevention, breast feeding, nutrition, Diabetes, Hypertension, yoga, Antenatal care through our health centres and medical camps, health and awareness camp for schools, orphanages and old age homes.

Central Diagnostic Laboratory

Vision: Our Central Laboratory was created to increase the spectrum, coverage and overall efficiency of laboratory testing in the region.

Mission: To offer high quality, efficient and accurate testing with fast and reliable turnaround times.

The central Diagnostic Laboratory of Aarupadai Veedu Medical College and Hospital is situated in the hospital block, headed by Dr.Manju.M, Professor, Dept. of Biochemistry. The fully air conditioned and computerized laboratory is located in an area of about 2350 sq. feet and performs around 3000 diagnostic tests per day in areas of Biochemistry, Clinical Pathology, Haematology and Microbiology, completely free of cost. The lab services are available 24x7.

It has a spacious blood collection area and separate processing areas for Biochemistry, Pathology and Microbiology. The laboratory is equipped fully with automated analyzers like Horiba, Mindray, Chemwell etc. Qualified consultants from all the three departments take part in the diagnostics







and are aided by qualified and experienced technicians.

We maintain turnaround time of around 4 hours for regular samples and 1 hour or less in instances of emergency.

Reporting of the samples is done only after two levels of internal quality controls pass the quality checks. Reports are stored in database and issued in typed format.

All NABH recommended standards are followed and 8-10 quality indicators are maintained on a

regular basis.

Research: The Central Laboratory plays a major role in faculty research, Post graduate research and dissertations, STS projects and under graduate research.

We conduct practical training programs for Allied Health Sciences and Paramedical courses of our Institute and short term training programs for students from other institutions in branches of Bio technology, MLT and Biomedical Engineering.


